

PROJECT GUIDELINES

Dear Sirs,

Being the owner, since 2001, of the property shown on the enclosed map, registration and photos, I am interested in starting a number of activities, which will benefit the property itself, as well as it will bring a new added value to the surrounding geographical area.

The project I have planned, whose ultimate purpose is to create a number of fundamental infrastructures which will allow the property to be used in order to explore a number of environmental and ecological activities, including:

- The continuous support of the ongoing scientific research projects initiated by BIOTA Southern Africa with the establishment of “Biodiversity Observatories”, whose activities are already being developed inside the property.
- The study of wildlife, plants and soil by universities, colleges or other organizations who may be interested in developing new environmentally friendly technologies and processes, or to further their current studies on the mentioned areas of study;
- To promote and develop agricultural projects and, at the same time, provide an environment where new techniques, technologies and working methods can be observed and studied;
- To promote and develop researches with the objective of finding and improving methods of capturing alternate sources of energy, taking advantage of the wind and sun, naturally available in the region.
- Create the necessary infrastructures in order to develop a new site for environmental tourism, which will target a growing number of individuals who look for remote places, with environmental value, where they can spend their vacations, observing and photographing wildlife in their own habitat, as well as learning and often participating in ongoing projects.

In order to achieve the above mentioned goals, the project demands an immediate intervention in the following areas:

- The creation of a dense vegetation borderline around the whole property, about 50 meters wide, basically made out of trees and decorative bushes;
- The immediate prohibition of any and all hunting activities, in order to preserve and protect the current existing local wildlife;
- The immediate prohibition of the use of chemicals, inside the property, or any other products and materials which can be harmful to the environment or both the existing and future wildlife and vegetation.
